NOOD INFORMATION:

WAIVER FORMS:

You and your crew are required to sign the enclosed waiver form in order to race in this event. **Please bring the signed waiver form to registration. Without a signed waiver form you will not be officially entered into the event. Do not fax this to us or turn it in to the Sailing offices of the Yacht Clubs, it will not be accepted.** Crew changes will require a new waiver form to be signed and turned in to Sailing World throughout the weekend during registration or before racing each day.

ELIGIBILITY:

As per Notice of Race, section 3.3, the owner and/or skipper of each boat must be a member of their National Governing Body (US SAILING for US boats, CYA for Canadian boats).

Please note that because being a member of your National Governing Body is a prerequisite of eligibility, it is possible for you to be protested out of the regatta if you are not in compliance.

PFDs are required to be worn by individuals racing aboard boats that do not have fixed keels. The wearing of PFDs by individuals sailing aboard all other boats is encouraged.

REGISTRATION:

Each boat owner or his/her representative must report to Registration at CYC to complete registration details. For all classes, Registration will be held at the Corinthian Yacht Club Shilshole between 5:00pm and 8:00pm on Thursday May 15th and on Friday May 16th from 8:00am to 9:00am. The Skippers' Meeting for Keelboats will be held at 9:00am on Friday, May 16th, at the CYC.

For classes only competing 2 days (Centerboard Fleets), further registration will be held 6:00pm to 8:00pm on Friday May 16th or Saturday May 17th from 7:30am to 8:30am at the Corinthian Yacht Club Shilshole. The Skippers' Meeting for the Centerboard boats will be held at 8:30am on Saturday, May 17th, at the Corinthian Yacht Club.

Sailing Instructions and Social Tickets will be available at Registration.

TICKET INFORMATION:

All participants wishing to partake in the NOOD Regatta sponsored parties must have tickets. Tickets will be good for Friday, Saturday and Sunday's NOOD evening parties for the food and drink. NO tickets were included in your entry fee.

1) Social tickets purchased with your entry were \$40.00. If you included payment for tickets with your entry fee, you will receive them when you register. Tickets purchased at registration or at the door will be \$45.00.

Tickets purchased at the door will be by cash or credit card only.

2) Before the party starts, each ticket will be hole-punched on the appropriate day and a wristband will be put on you. Proof of age 21 will be required for a second wristband. You will not receive the sponsored drinks or food without the correct wristbands.

3) That day's wristband is only good for that evening's party. The next day the ticket will be hole-punched again and a new wristband/or wristbands will be issued.

YOU MUST FOLLOW THIS PROCEDURE EVERY DAY.

The social ticket is transferable among crew or guests; however, each day's daily wrist band is not transferable. You will not need to wear the wristbands while racing.

Members of reciprocal clubs that arrange with the front desk will be issued guest cards allowing them to charge club food and beverages to either their MasterCard or Visa. GENERAL INFORMATION:

Fuel Dock Shilshole Bay Marina

Open 7 days a week year round. Minimum hours are 8 AM-5 PM. Hours will increase by mid-May. 206-783-7555. Monitors VHF channel 17.

Gasoline, diesel, B20 biodiesel blend, kerosene, CNG. End of H Dock.

The Port of Seattle operates a pump out at the outer end of the dock.

Convenience store carries ice, beverages, snacks, and local guidebooks.

A complete boatyard (Seaview West) with Travelift haulout is at the south end of the marina. The boatyard has propane and repair-yard supplies

LAUNCH SERVICE:

A wide launch ramp is located north of the marina. This is operated by the Seattle Parks Department. Day use is \$6. \$8 for each overnight. So \$14 for one overnight and \$8 for each next night up to 4 night's total. A vehicle must be attached to the trailer or, this is null and void and the trailer will be towed. This is on a first come first served basis in the lot north of Little Coney, north of the Marina.

HOISTS:

There are 3 hoists located close to Corinthian Yacht Club at the north end of Shilshole Bay Marina. There will be no charge for hoist service courtesy of the Port of Seattle. It is available at the following hours:

3 PM-8 PM Thursday May 15th

7-10 AM and 3- 6 PM Friday May 16

7-9:30 AM and 3:30-6 PM Saturday May 17th

7-9:30 AM and 2-5 PM Sunday May 18th

Hoist service will be performed by Port waived operators only.

DOCKAGE AND DRY STORAGE:

Dock space and dry storage will be assigned according to reservations on a first come first serve basis. We will try to accommodate all boats at no charge as best as we can. Moorage for additional nights will be a cost to the participant.
